



An Aquarium for the 21st Century

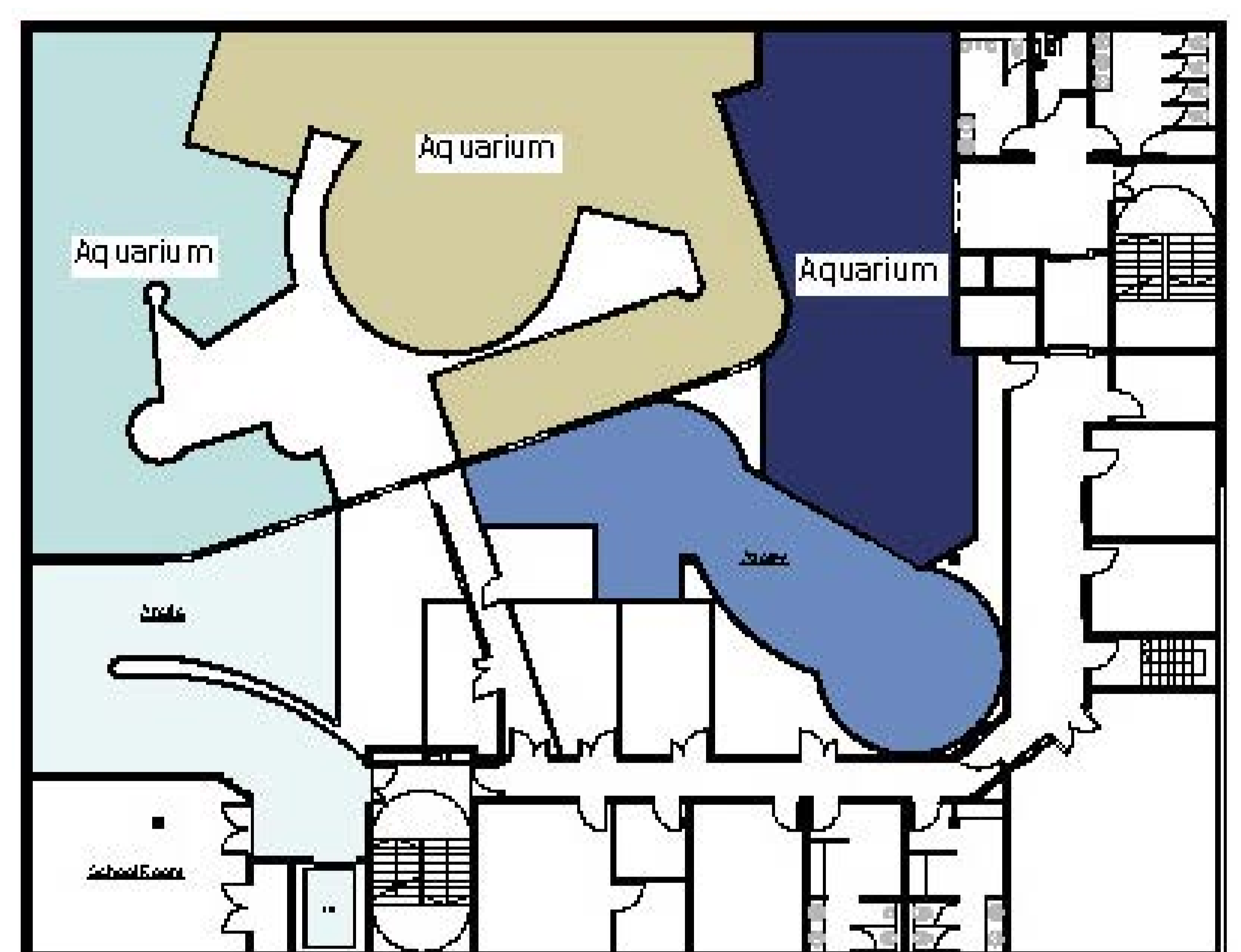

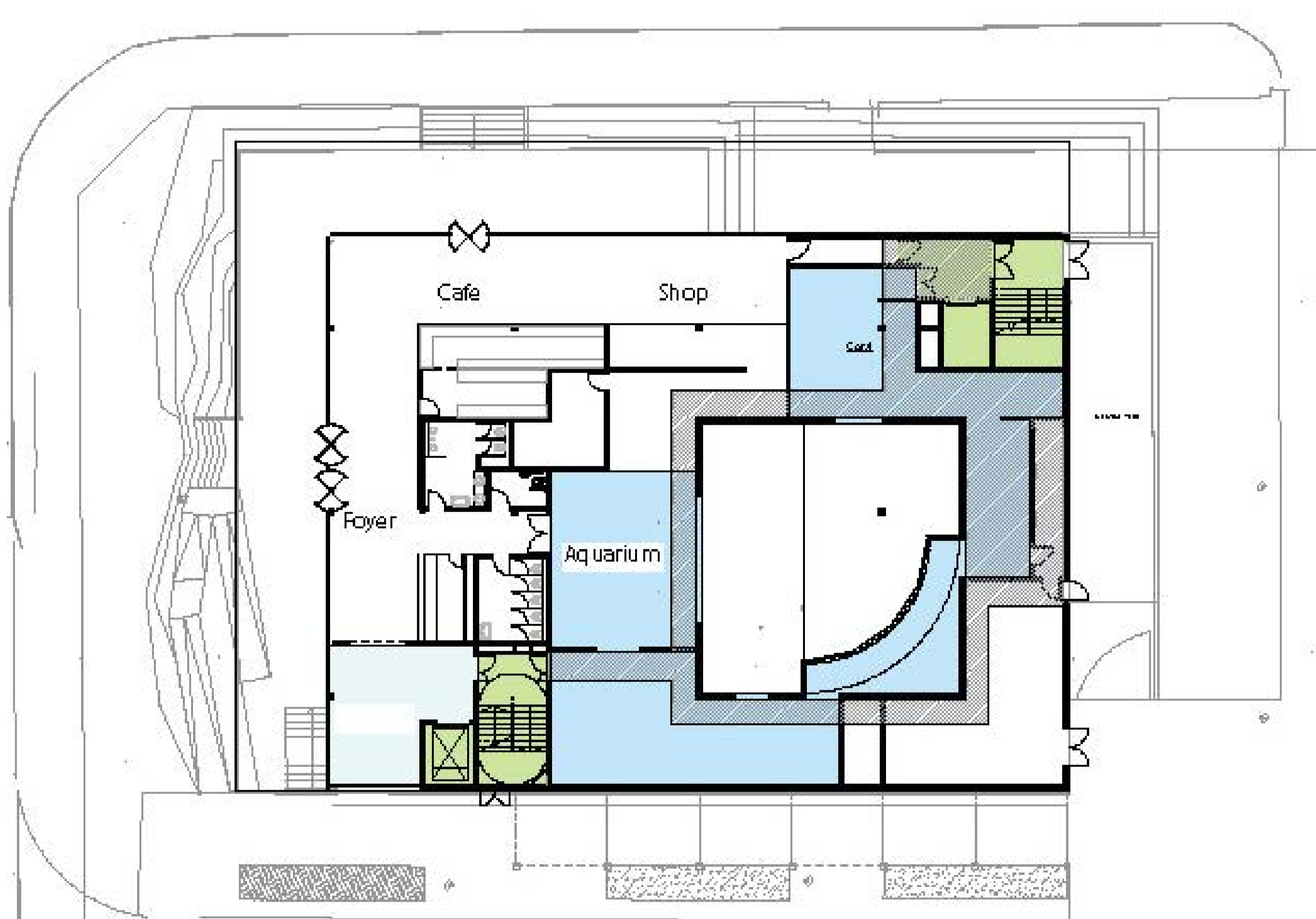
reefLIVE aims to inspire and educate visitors about the marine environment and how it can and should be properly managed and conserved.

The ground floor provides access to the ticketing area but also to the retail area, providing visitors with the opportunity to purchase high-quality branded merchandise including souvenirs and branded merchandise, guides, books, DVDs etc. A great quality daytime F&B offering in the form of a café will serve locally-sourced produce, whilst at night, the aquarium will offer unique corporate and private hire opportunities besides the main Coral Reef Ocean tank.

The upper floor accommodates the main area of exhibition space and much of the ancillary areas required for servicing the aquarium, including laboratories, staff facilities and offices.
